

PCV Whip Rule for Rallies, Clinics and Camps

At all PCV affiliated training events and activities, such as rallies, clinics and camps, a rider may use a whip, if required.

Permissible whips are:

- Not exceeding 750 mm including a compulsory flat flap on the end, which must not be weighted; or
- Not exceeding 1200 mm including a compulsory lash.

While riding, hands must not be placed through whip handle straps.

Cutting a handle strap is not a requirement.

Removing a whip flap is not allowed.

Note: This is equivalent to Rule 10.10 of the PCV Gear Rules 2022, and still applies at all PCV affiliated rallies and activities. Effective immediately.
