The outside of the track means keeping close to the right hand rail</u></p> <p><i>Ride To Time Zone Coaches will be timing your trial. You will trot/canter off individually approximately from the 1200m point and the clocker in the tower will time you from 1000m marker. Your time starts when your body passes the 1000m and finish line.</i></p> <p><i>When the person ahead of you is approximately halfway around the track, you will be called for your turn.</i></p> <p>You must be ready and do exactly as you are asked by event officials, <u>when</u> you are asked as time is of the essence.</p>	Riders/ Clerk of the Course
When riders finish their round	<i>When you cross the finish line you must continue around the track until you see a volunteer on the course who will direct you to the way back to the float area. Please come back to a trot on approaching them. A second clerk of course horse will be positioned at the 1600m mark to assist riders if necessary.
